

SHERMAN'S MILL



A pioneer Kerr County water-powered mill located near Kelly Creek-Guadalupe River confluence. It ground corn, sawed lumber, ginned cotton. Built in 1870s by John Sherman, it was in use until destroyed by flood in 1932. Sherman, his wife, and 8 children lived in house still standing nearby. Incise on base of marker: Marker Sponsor: A Sherman descendant, Dovie Turk Talley. (1972)

Location: north side of TX 39 & Kelly Creek Road intersection between Ingram & Hunt

Driving Directions: from Ingram, 3.4 mi. W. on TX 39, N. side of the road.
