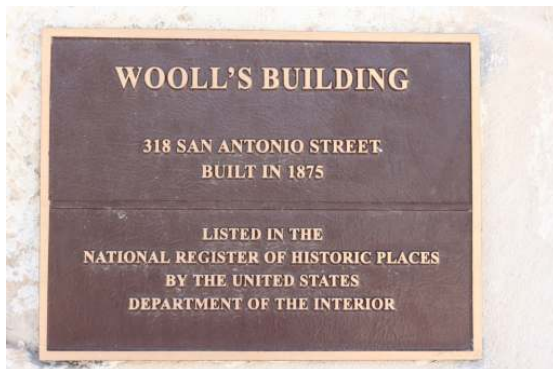


WOOLL'S BUILDING



One of the oldest commercial structures in Center Point, built by George W. Woolls, who died in 1878, to house his mercantile business. Local stonemason, Sam H. Wellborn, constructed the limestone building with a full width balcony and outside staircase to the upper floor, where fraternal organizations met from 1875 to 1900. Retail businesses occupied the first floor. The Rising Star Masonic Lodge moved to their building across the street in 1964. Recorded Texas Historical landmark. (2001) Listed on National Register.
